Please join us at the 16th Annual Medication Safety Conference. We are seeking poster presentations from nurses, pharmacists, physicians, and our interdisciplinary healthcare partners to augment the program presented by Geisinger faculty and other content experts in the industry.

The topic of medication safety has risen to the forefront for both providers and consumers of healthcare. This issue receives a tremendous amount of attention, not only in medical journals, but magazines and daily newspapers. According to the Institute for Safe Medication Practice (ISMP), incorrect use of medications resulted in more than 9 million hospital admissions and more than 18 million emergency room visits.¹ In addition, serious preventable medication errors occur in 3.8 million inpatient admissions and 3.3 million outpatient visits each year nationwide.²

The objectives of the conference are: 1) to review the scope, complexity, and implications of medication errors that can extend well beyond our interaction with the patient, 2) discuss current concepts and evidence-based practices that exist to assist in providing error-free care to our patients, and 3) examine the human factors, organizational culture and the accountability needed to achieve ZERO medication errors.

The target audience for the conference is professionals who prescribe, prepare, profile, or administer medications including Physicians, Nurses, Pharmacists, Respiratory Therapists, Mid-Level Providers, Students, and Educators.

Posters from interdisciplinary teams are strongly encouraged!

Current Concepts in Medication Safety Conference

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1. Submit a completed Poster Presentation Form found on pages 3-5. Only email submission will be considered.
2. Submit an abstract of 250 words or less outlining the content you plan to include in your poster. Please use 12 font Times New Roman or Arial.
 - a. For Research posters, please address the following:
 - Purpose, theoretical/conceptual framework, design, sample, methods, findings, discussions/implications.
 - b. For all other posters, please address the following:
 - Objectives, description of project, outcomes, implications for practice, education, and/or administration.
3. Reference to commercialism and promotion/advertising of products or services is prohibited.
4. **The deadline for submitting abstracts is February 2, 2026.**
5. Each submission will be peer-reviewed by a minimum of four members of the Medication Safety Conference Planning Committee. Abstracts will be selected based on relevance to conference objectives.
6. **Authors will be notified by February 9, 2026.**
7. **The deadline for submitting completed posters is February 25, 2026. An emailed PDF version of the poster is required.**
8. Authors are encouraged to be at their posters and available for questions during the time specified on the program.
9. Authors from the top four posters will be required to present a summary their poster at one of the following times: before the two breaks and before and after lunch. **Authors will be notified by March 4, 2026.**
